Rentals:

We will have rental dulcimers available for those who need them. If you would like to rent a dulcimer, please let us know ahead of time so that we can make sure there will be a dulcimer for you.

T-Shirts and Zippered Tote bags:

T-shirts will be purple this year, printed in lime green with the 2012 logo (full size) on the front of the shirt.

Long-sleeved shirts will also be purple, and will have a smaller logo on the left chest. Both shirts are 100% cotton (medium weight).

Tote bags will be purple, printed with the same logo in lime green ink. They have a zippered main compartment, a contoured main front pocket, an inside zippered hanging pocket, a gusseted front-side pocket and adjustable handles. Size: 15" wide x 13" high x 4" deep.

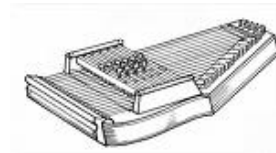
Previously Loved Instrument Sale
