We will have rental dulcimers available for those who need them. If you would like to rent a dulcimer, please let us know ahead of time so that we can make sure there will be a dulcimer for you.

T-Shirts and Zippered Tote bags:



T-shirts will be Carolina Blue this year, printed in full color with the 2015 logo (full size) on the front of the shirt.

Long-sleeved shirts will also be Carolina Blue, and will have a smaller logo on the left chest. Both shirts are 100% cotton (medium weight).



Tote bags will be light blue, printed with the same logo in a single color, dark green. They have a zippered main compartment, a contoured main front pocket, an inside zippered hanging pocket, a gusseted front-side pocket and adjustable handles. Size: 15" wide x 13" high x 4" deep.

T-shirts and tote bags must be ordered in advance when you send in your registration. (A limited number of t-shirts and tote bags *may* be available at the festival for those who do not pre-register, but ... Prices are:

Long sleeve shirt	\$20 (sizes S – 5XL)
Tote bag:	\$15

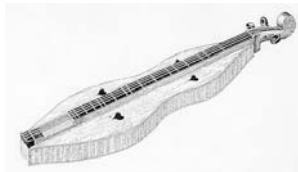
Open Stage
