
Previously loved Instrument Sale 2023

Information needed: A list of the instruments you plan to bring, with any relevant info you would like to have folks know about each instrument (Builder, type of wood, date built, anything else you care to say about the instrument) - including the price you are asking. We will make up a card or tag for each instrument, so that whoever is in the room as a volunteer at the time won't be stumpedif prospective "customers" ask questions about any of the instruments.
